## Our courses




### 1. Pathway to Work



This course can last from 1-3 years but at your own pace depending on your previous experience and qualifications as you prepare for voluntary or paid employment.



### 2. Pathway to Further Education



This course is normally 1-2 years with a focus on personal social development, safety, travel and independence as you prepare to go to mainstream college.

## About our Bradford Centre

### Who are these courses for?

If you would like to become a volunteer, paid employee or enter self-employment in the future but need extra support to do so, our courses can help you get there. We normally work with young adults with special educational needs and disabilities aged 16-25 years who have an Education, Health and Care Plan.

### Assessment and progression

In your first term we will assess your individual learning support needs and make a plan to enable you to become more independent over time. We know this happens at a different pace for everyone. As your confidence grows, the level of support you need will be gradually reduced. You might complete step 1 within one term rather than one year, and be ready to progress to the next step.

### Qualifications – Maths, English, Communication & ICT

We focus on equipping you with skills to meet the requirement of your job role or the vocational area you've chosen to study. This can also include access to qualifications if they will help you to do this e.g. Functional Skills in English, Communication, Maths and ICT, Employability units or sector-specific certificates such as Food Hygiene.

### Work based placement learning

All courses include a minimum of 100 hours work based placement learning to prepare you for employment or further study. Job coaching is available throughout so you will develop the confidence to work as independently as possible with reduced reliance on support over time.

### Independence and personal safety

You will develop your personal, social and communication skills to prepare for working with others. Through travel training in the local area, we'll enable you to learn safe routes to and from the workplace or mainstream college.

### Enhanced learning opportunities

Take part in the Duke of Edinburgh's Award Scheme to develop your social, communication and independence skills. Set up and run a commercial business as part of a team through our Young Enterprise activities.

### Specialist support services

Our Therapy, Educational and Sensory Support team can deliver a wide range of health and support services. These include Speech and Language Therapy, Assistive Technology, Occupational Therapy, Physiotherapy, Sensory Support and Mobility/Travel Training.

### Facilities

Henshaws Bradford Centre is fully accessible with well-equipped teaching rooms, modern kitchen and large open plan areas. It occupies a central location, close to Bradford University and College, with excellent transport links. Students can also access specialist therapy and leisure facilities at our Harrogate campus.
